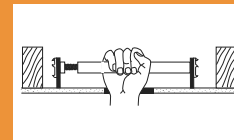
#### Step 1

Easy installation from below ceiling through any 4" diameter hole.



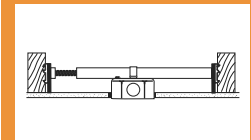
#### Step 2
